Registration for the NorthStar Academy U12 team is completed online. Space is limited (first come, first served) to the first twenty-four (24) players—two teams. Initial payment is due at time of online registration. Please check U12 Player Budget information at U12 webpage.

Team Meeting/Player Registration Event

The registration day for all NorthStar Academy teams to complete required paperwork (paperwork-pictures-medical release-birth certificates, etc.) will be on a date - yet to be determined - in early August. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT A PARENT AND THE PLAYER ATTEND THIS REGISTRATION EVENT. If you cannot attend, **prior** notification **MUST** be given to the coach and the Team Business Manager. Fall/Spring League Play: U12 NMSA (Northern Michigan Soccer Alliance)

The U12 team will compete in MNSA U12 division play. We will have home and away games that will be scheduled prior to each season. These games will be played on weekends. Fall season is between the second weekend in September and the last weekend in October. Spring season typically begins April 15 and ends June 15.
